

Attached you will find the photocopies of the "Testimony of Orders Received" as well as the Master of Divinity Diploma.

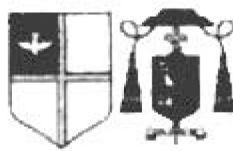




